Child, Adolescent & Family Services

Centerstone provides innovative treatment programs for children, youth and their families. Your contribution would benefit priority programs such as:

Therapeutic Preschool Program – a structured program for young children (preschoolers) who are victims of (or high-risk for) neglect, emotional, physical or sexual abuse.

School-Based Counseling – providing on-site counseling and case management services to children and youth (currently in 51 schools in the region).

Prevention Programs – provided in the school setting, research-based curricula promote the message of healthy beliefs and clear standards of behaviors to youth and their families to achieve successful outcomes in the areas of alcohol and drug abuse, social skills, violence, STD, teen pregnancy and character development.

Regional Intervention Program (RIP) – an internationally recognized, parent-implemented program, where parents learn to work directly with their own preschool age children who are having behavior difficulties.

Adults

Centerstone’s services for adults range from individual and couples counseling to treatment for problems such as panic, anxiety and stress. Other services address substance abuse and mental illness including depression, bipolar disorder and schizophrenia, as well as working with specialized populations such as immigrants, refugees and the homeless.

Older Adults / Seniors

Older adults face very specific challenges and Centerstone addresses those needs with services like in-home counseling, substance abuse treatment and case management services that provide assistance with accessing ancillary community resources and services.
